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CONSULTATION REVIEW

This booklet provides an overview and findings of the 2018 Menphys Review.

Menphys is a long-established charity whose vision is to support disabled children, young people and families in Leicester and Leicestershire through a range of different services.

In June 2018, following the loss of Local Authority funding, we took the opportunity to review our objectives and the future direction of the charity. This was with a view that we should continue to offer support to children and young people with disabilities and their families.

WE ASKED...

The review consisted of collecting the views of both current and potential service users about existing services and the kinds of provisions that they would like.

The consultation included the use of online surveys, social media and focus groups to collect the views of Young People, Parents and Carers, along with our own Staff, Volunteers and Trustees.

Parents and Carers

- Access to short breaks and activities including evenings, after school and school holidays
- Activities that the whole family can engage in
- A competent Buddy Service that offers assurances regarding Personal Assistants and Support Workers
- Emotional support including forums, social meetings and emotional support services
- Access to information and advice through face-to-face, telephone and online
